was my husbands grandfather. He had 3 children :-

2. **Lee Howard Northcut Jnr.** 1924-1977 m. Faith Winifred Giddings 1922-2006 in Bury St. Edmunds, England, UK

3. Edward Eugene Northcut b. 1925-

**Lee Howard Jnr.** and Faith Giddings had 4 children the eldest of which is my husband **Lee Howard Northcut III**. b. 1947-

**Lee Howard Jnr.** re-married after a divorce a further 3 children who live in the UK

He returned to the US in the late 50s where he I believe remarried a third time.

I am interested in finding the early link of Northcutts here in the UK, it is not a common name even with its variations. I am now looking for evidence of Northcuts taking ship to the new world either voluntarily or otherwise.

I have photocopies of source information on most of the above information. I hope this may help to fill in a very small gap in your research.
