Beersheba Springs including Panhandle and Utah Beersheba Springs Historic District was added to the National Register of Historical Places in 1980



The Beersheba Hotel began as a row of cabins in 1833 and developed into a beautiful structure. The hotel failed in the 1930's and was purchased by the **United Methodist Church in** Tennessee for the Assembly Grounds.


Northcutt's Store was located near the hotel.
















