Baptised 16 Feb 1776 Rucking

Was a Trustee of a Church in Breeden, England

Established "Shepherds House Boarding School" at Cranbrook for forty pupils. When his son John(1912) was old enough he was educated at the school. After school at the Shepherds House his son went in with him to help operate the school and they ch nged the name of the school to the "John Francis and Son Academy."

Broad Oak Academy was a boarding school in Sussex that had 60 day schollars and 40 boarders most of children were frompros erous tradesmen and farmer families.

Outbreak of smallpox in 1829 caused the Academy to be closed and John moved to Cranbrook. Prior to leaving Mr Francis issued a handbill defending himself against charges of negligence and concealment. "Mr. Francis....has deeply to lament, thataft r a residence in Broad Oak for about 13 years, there should be found one capable of endeavouring to conceal such a dreadful disease in his house, and thereby expose his neighbours and nearly a hundred children under his tution to its direful contagion." After he retired from the Shepherds House/John Francis & son Academy John lived in a house on a hill in Cranbrook called Albi n until his death. Phillis died before 1860 as he mentioned in a letter that his housekeeper had levt her employ.

He spoke of cousins that lived near Hamstreet

Jabez Francis was a son of his brother William worked the Shepherd house with his son John as a printer. Later Japez moved to R ckford.

Oliver (Francis)lived near Jabez (in Rockford)

Preacher Joseph T. Francis lived in London. He could have been another son of William.

Notes for Mary LOWRIE

Came to Tracy City with Her Sister Ellen probably from Cincinnati, Ohio. She operated the Parker House and the Assembly Inn n the Assembly Grounds in Monteagle.

Mary bought the second stained glass from the front on the right side of Morton Memorial MC in Monteagle. There is no inscription on the window just a depiction of a white dove. That was the way she wanted it per Anna Mary Parker.
