THE NERVIE LONG GIPSON JOURNALS

Transcribed by Judy Henley Phillips

This transcribed journal, and another, became the property of Rickey Hill. They were given to him by his Aunt Margie Hill Gipson the wife of Joe Dick Gipson. Margie inherited them from her mother. Rickey brought these journals for me to transcribe.

The two fragile Agricultural books he was given had been used by Nervie Long Gipson for journals to record names, birth and death dates, and other family information around the margins of the books printed text. There are obituaries and other papers stored within the pages of the two books. At least one other person made entries as can be seen by the inscription changes. There seems to be a lot of entries for the month of February.

This transcription is based on what we may refer to as the first journal which ends on page 318. The second journal, which has no front or back cover, begins with page 319 and ends with page 712.

The first journal has a front and back with tape holding it together. A portion of the tape covers part of the title, which is: "_______ YEARBOOK, 1914." On the left side of the pages is the heading: Yearbook of the Department of Agriculture. The book has to be constantly rotated to follow the inscriptions around the pages. The handwriting and spelling is very difficult to read. I have left the spelling as found; periods are added in order to separate each entry. I have arranged the entries by the original page numbers of the old book. Sometimes an entry is made more than once. Some pages have "rote By Nervie Gipson" or "N.G." I have placed word clarifications of the writings in brackets to the best of my ability.

We can see from these entries that there were quite a few house fires. We can only imagine the Bibles with family records, photos, and other historical information that went into the flames. We can be thankful for the effort put into recording the information into these journals. This had to be a very family caring person. Although the writing might be difficult to read, we would be grateful to have such writings from our ancestors.

Following is a description of Nervie's immediate family. I believe if you follow their genealogy you will know who

is being referred to within the pages of the journal.
