


John Anderegg Sr., Murdered Mar. 17, 1914

We failed to record in our last weeks issue about the death of Mr. John Anderegg, who was murdered in Pratt City, Ala. A representative of The Herald secured the following particulars from his son, John Anderegg.

Mr. Anderegg was employed as night foreman at the pump station for the Tennessee Coal & Iron Co., and while at his duties supposedly about two o'clock in the morning, the murderer slipped up to his back and struck him in the back of the head with what is known as a track-walkers wrench. He was robbed of a ladies gold watch, a pistol and a small sum of money having deposited his money a few days before in the bank. While changing a \$20.00 bill he was seen by a very bad man of that place and is supposed he is the murderer as he has since disappeared. Six detectives are working on the case and arrest is expected shortly. Frank Phillips, who is well known at this place is one of the detectives working on the case. After being murdered, Mr. Anderegg was locked up in the pumping station by the murderer, and on account of the pump stopping at 2 a.m. A man then went and found him. He lived till the next day but never regained consciousness. He is survived by wife and the following children who are grown Mrs. Kate Stoker, Mrs. Lizzie McBride, John, Henry, Frank and Albert Anderegg. He was a member of the Royal Arcanum Lodge.

Tracy City, Tenn., April 6.—Mrs. Elizabeth Anderegg, 81, widow of John Anderegg, died at the home of her son, Henry Anderegg, at Whitwell Sunday, and the body was interred in the city cemetery this afternoon. She was born at in Werringen, Switzerland, was married to John Anderegg there in 1869, came to this country immediately after marriage and located at Tracy City. Mr. Anderegg died at Birmingham several years ago. Mrs. Anderegg is survived by the following children; John Anderegg, Huntland, Tenn; Henry Anderegg, Whitwell, Tenn; Albert Anderegg, Birmingham, Ala; Frank Anderegg, Dallas Tex; Mrs Ed McBride, Ensley, Ala., and Mrs J. J. Stocker, Palmer, Tenn. Also one sister, Mrs. Kennedy, of Monteagle.
