

I J. L. Lusk of Tracy City Grundy County Tennessee being now of sound mind and deposing memory, and knowing the uncertainty of life, and certainty of death do this day make and publish this as my last Will and Testament, hereby recalling and making void all others by me at any time made.

First. I direct that my funeral expenses, and all my debts be paid as soon after my death as possible, out of any moneys that I may die possessed of, or may first come into the hands of my Executor.

Secondly I give and bequeath to Mary Elizabeth Lusk my beloved wife all the Real Estate, and personal property of every kind and character that I may die possessed of, to be used and controlled by her during her natural life, and at her death to be equally divided among my Children. Said Real Estate Consisting of three (3) one half acre lots, and including the place where we now reside in Tracy City Tenn. Also a 4th lot including part of a lane near our said residence purchased of T. B. Roddy, and for a definite description of said 3 1/2 acre lots reference is here made to Deeds from S. W. Payne to me now of Record in the

Registers office of Grand County Tennessee
and the part of Lane to deed from The said
T. B. Reddy to me as of Record in said County
and State, All of the foregoing Real Estate, as
well as all personal property of every kind as
aforesaid which I may die possessed of I give
and bequeath to my wife Mary E. Lusk to be
used & Controlled by her free from molestation
during her life, and at her death what may
be remaining to be equally divided among
my several Children

Thirdly & Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint
Mary E. Lusk my wife my Executrix to this
my said Will, and do excuse her from
executing bond as such
